



Job Title: Environmental Audit and Bin Delivery Team

Position Start: Immediately

Time Frame: This is a seasonal contract position for part-time/casual work in the Fall. Hours are not guaranteed due to the nature of position. Job hours vary but are typically during daytime hours and can include evenings and weekends.

Wage: \$16 per hour

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Prepping and loading bins for delivery.
- Deliveries of recycling bins to homes and businesses.
- Keeping an accurate daily count of bins delivered.
- Conducting assessments of waste and recycling material to determine recycling recovery rates in key areas across Manitoba, which may include:
 - Waste and recycling material collection;
 - Waste and recycling material sorting;
 - Waste disposal behavioural observations.
- Other duties as assigned.

Position Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Understand or have an interest in current environmental and waste management issues.
- Must be able to work as a member of a team and with minimal supervision.
- Must have proof of covid vaccinations.
- Able to perform physical duties of the job, including lifting at least 40 pounds.
- Willing to travel throughout Manitoba.
- Must be a bondable individual.
- Possess a valid Class 5 driver's license with a clean drivers abstract.
- Must have a reliable means of getting to and from the Recycle Everywhere warehouse location.
- University or College degree, completed or in progress, in a related field is an asset.
